Robinson received her 35-year service pin at the LaGrange City Council meeting Tuesday (10/22) night.

Captain Robinson was hired August 29th, 1984 and continues to work for the City of LaGrange in the LaGrange Police Department.

"Captain Robinson has been a very conscientious and loyal employee of the LaGrange Police Department for over 35 years. She exemplifies our Basic Employment Standards by embracing accountability, honesty, and integrity," said LPD Chief Lou Dekmar. "She demonstrates problemsolving and sound judgement in discharging her responsibilities. She consistently identifies issues or training needs and communicates these effectively through proper channels to ensure positive change. Her continual monitoring of all issues of state and national crime reporting compliance, as well as the intricacies of our Record Management System, contributes to the accuracy of UCR reporting and accurate internal crime statistics."

Robinson has never taken a sick leave in 35 years. In her position she schedules and monitors GCIC training for all Departmental terminal operators, as well as Security Awareness Training. She responds to external customers for various records requests, as well as expediting various requests of reports and videos from the various court systems.

As the Records Officer, Robinson processes more than 150 substantial records requests annually and she is always cognizant of documenting and maintaining her responses in compliance with the current laws governing the various types of records requirements.

Captain Robinson, also completes first-line supervisor responsibilities, such as personnel hiring, bi-monthly counseling, evaluations and corrective actions in a timely manner.

She has always promoted and demonstrated honesty and integrity in her behavior, both within and outside of the workplace. She contributes to a positive work environment by treating her constituents and employees with respect and courtesy, while requiring this same conduct from her Division members.
