Construction Expected Near Colquitt and Ragland Streets for Three Weeks, Crews Constructing Sidewalks Connected to The Thread

LaGrange, Ga. October 22, 2018 – Residents are advised to use caution around Colquitt and Ragland Streets for the next few weeks.

Work crews will be constructing sidewalks on Colquitt and Ragland Streets. The new sidewalks will connect the second segment of The Thread to the Greenwich, Tamarack, and Tucker Cottage communities.

“The Thread is an example of a partnership between the City and Friends of The Thread as well as community partners to create an amenity that will improve the city’s walkability and enhance the quality of life for all,” said Public Services Director Dion Senn.

“The current project to add sidewalks on Colquitt and Ragland Streets will connect various neighborhoods to The Thread and each other.”

The project began with the addition of curbs to the roadways. The sidewalks are expected to be completed in the next three weeks.
