Dozens Participate in City of LaGrange Zoning Public Meeting, Public Encouraged to Participate

LaGrange, Ga. December 10, 2018 – Dozens of engaged citizens attended the City of LaGrange public meeting Thursday, December 6th to learn about the Unified Development Ordinance that the City is drafting to create a user-friendly set of development regulations that promote quality growth.

A Unified Development Ordinance is a document that combines traditional zoning and subdivision regulations, along with other desired city regulations, such as design guidelines and stormwater management, into one document.

As part of this project, the City is updating the current zoning ordinance and staff is requesting the public's input. At the public meeting on December 6th, citizens had the

opportunity to provide input about zoning and development related topics.

This was the first of several opportunities the public will have to engage the process.
