LPD Animal Services Recovers Thirty Dogs in Hoarding Investigation

LaGrange, Ga. May 31, 2019 – LaGrange Police Department’s Animal Services recovered thirty Mastiff mixed breed dogs Friday following a hoarding investigation.

Animal Services crews worked with LPD Code Enforcement, LPD Community Outreach, City Community Development, Troup County Marshall’s Office, and Hogansville Police on this investigation on North Barnard Avenue in LaGrange.

Investigators have declared the residence unfit for human habitation.

The owner of the residence surrendered the dogs to Animal Services.

All thirty dogs, including nine puppies, will be available for adoption starting Monday, June 3rd.
