

COMMERCIAL SANITATION CHANGES

The City of LaGrange accepted an offer from LaGrange Sanitation Services to purchase the city's commercial sanitation assets. Current commercial sanitation customers should have received a letter from the city. If the customer wants to have a seamless transition, they will have the opportunity to keep their current dumpsters but will need to sign a new service agreement with the new provider.



Effective 6/1/19, if a business utilizes a dumpster, the city will no longer service the dumpster. The new solid waste provider will reach out to existing city customers in the next few weeks.

The following city services will **NOT** be affected:

- Residential Sanitation any resident or business who utilizes a rolling trash bin
- Curbside Recycling
- Yard Waste/Limbs & Leaves
- Household Waste
